## PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Job Description: Bus Mechanic

- 1. Repairs, replaces and performs complete overhauls on engines on systemowned vehicles, including trucks, cars, and mowers
- 2. Repairs and replaces air/hydraulic brake and cooling systems
- 3. Repairs and replaces electronic components on buses and other system owned vehicles

- 4. Performs miscellaneous preventive maintenance and service calls as needed
- 5. Maintain a neat and orderly work area
- 6. Drives a school bus as needed
- 7. Lift objects that exceed 50 lbs
- 8. Perform frequent lifting and /or carrying of objects weighing up to 25 lbs.
- 9. Perform physical demands such as pushing, pulling, climbing, balancing, bending, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling and reaching
- 10. Performs other related duties as assigned
- 11. Work as a team member with other transportation employees
