## Math

\*i-Ready Math Packet: This at-home activity packet includes 15 sets of practice problems that align to important math concepts your student has worked with so far this year. We recommend that your student completes one page of practice problems each day. Specific instructions to guide your student are found at the bottom of each page. Encourage your student to do the best they can with this content— the most important things is that they continue developing their mathematical fluency and skills.

\*Numbers 0-20 Flashcards: Choose one of the activities to do with the flashcards each day.

## Reading

\*i-Ready Reading Packet: This at-home activity packet includes 4 stories and activities. We recommend that your student completes one story per week. Children will most likely need the support of an adult or older student to complete these lessons. Encourage your student to do the best they can with this content. The most important thing is that they continue to work on their reading! \*EL Skills at Home: These activities are very similar to what we have been doing at school. Please use this to practice the alphabet, sight words, and decodable readers.

\*Sight Word Flashcards: Choose one of the activities to do with the flashcards each day.
