WHAT IS CREDIT RECOVERY

 Credit recovery is a course-specific, standards based extended learning opportunity for students who have previously been unsuccessful in mastering the standards required to receive course credit or earn promotion.

THE PURPOSE OF CREDIT RECOVERY

 The purpose of Credit recovery is to allow students the opportunity to retake an already failed course which is needed for graduation.

CREDIT RECOVERY SOFTWARE

- Credit Recovery courses will be completed through Edmentum
 - Students will receive login credentials after admission into the Credit Recovery Program

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- The student must sign-up to reserve a seat for Credit Recovery Shifts
 - During registration (if the student failed a course from the previous school year)
 - Sign-up sheets (posted in the front office)
 - By email to guidance counselor

GRADING POLICY

- To earn credit- No grade less than 70%
- 70% will replace the previously failed course grade
- Credit Recovery shall be denoted on the student's transcript

Note Credit recovery courses is not accepted by the NCAA Clearinghouse

CREDIT RECOVERY SHIFTS

- Each shift will consist of 30 full days
 - All Credit Recovery Students are required to log into Edmentum Monday – Thursday from 3:15p.m. -5:15 p.m.
 - Tomcat 1 will log on from home on Tuesdays and Thursdays
 - Will be in the lab on Mondays and Wednesdays
 - Tomcat 2 will log on from home on Mondays and Wednesdays
 - Will be in the lab on Tuesdays and Thursdays

PROGRAM POLICES FOR ADMISSION

- Parent or legal guardian written consent
- Taken the course previously
- Shown mastery of at least 50% of the course standards





Dear Parent/Guardian,

HHS and the HCS 21st Century After School Program are proving an opportunity for students who need credit recover. Current records indicate that the student _______ has failed one or more courses. It is important for the students to attend in order to progress toward graduation.

Sessions are held every **Monday-Thursday from 3:15 p.m. -5:15 p.m.** Students are required to be in attendance virtually or physical depending on their designated days. Transportation will be provided for on campus students after the completion of the after-school form.

*Note: Daily meeting and ending times may vary

During the two-hour sessions, students will complete course work through the program Edmentum. The student will be provided internet access along with an individual username and password while on campus.

The student **must complete all assigned work** in its entirety <u>and</u> be present for <u>30 full days</u> to receive full credit. Multiple absences will **not** be tolerated. **More than three absences during the attempted course will result in immediate dismissal from the program.** Students are required to work on lessons at home, but tests and quizzes must be completed during the credit recovery session. <u>Cheating is not acceptable!!!</u> Students are given all materials needed to be successful within the software. Evidence of plagiarism will result in a zero for the lesson, quiz, or test.

Students participating shall follow all rules in the Haywood County Schools code of conduct printed in the high school handbook. (A copy of the handbook is available in the school office as well as online). The use of the school provided equipment is for instructional purposes only; non-instructional use is prohibited. Any misuse of the technology will result in **immediate removal of the program**. Students must display respectful behavior toward the instructor, other students, and the school facility itself. If any violations of the code of conduct occur, the student is subject to immediate removal of the Credit Recovery Program.

Our goal is to provide students with an opportunity to demonstrate competency in core content. A second opportunity is offered to help the student achieve success while strengthening his/her learning experience as well as getting back on track to graduate.

In order for the student to participate and receive accommodations, the student is required to complete and return the Credit Recovery Student Agreement and the afterschool form and to join the remind messaging service for help.

Requires a weekly attendance of 4days over the duration of at least 9 consecutive weeks This includes if the student is on campus or at home

The students must attend the required four days (Monday-Thursday) to receive credit for a course taken. Lessons may be worked on at home, but test and quizzes must be taken during the time of the recovery session.

Only **THREE** unexcused absences are allowed to remain in the program. For an absence to be excused, prior communication is necessary. Also, **No Early Departures!** The students must remain in the credit recovery session for the entire duration of 3:15-5:15 if they are home or on campus unless there is an emergency or the session has been dismissed. Exceptions may be made for bus riders and walkers or inclement weather. **Two emergency early departures** will count as **one unexcused absence**.
